

## **COVID -19 INSERT for Student Handbook 20-21 School Year**

### **Parent/Teacher Conferences:**

Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held at the end of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> terms. These **may** be held as phone conferences per CDC and Pinal County Health recommendations.

### **Monthly Academic/ Family Involvement Events:**

Due to CDC and Pinal County Health recommendations, Parent Nights **may** be held VIRTUALLY until the guidelines have been updated to allow these in person. Information will be sent home MONTHLY with dates and times. Currently planned for every 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of each month.

We will not be holding any assemblies or indoor programs to avoid gathering of large groups until the guidelines have been updated to allow these.

### **Tutoring , Math Counts , Reading Rocks**

These extracurricular activities **may** be postponed until further guidance is issued from the CDC and Pinal County Health Dept.

### **Acceptable Use Policy**

An updated Acceptable Use Policy will be sent home with additional information regarding Distance/Virtual Learning agreements.

### **Athletics/Sports**

Varsity and JV sports seasons **may** be postponed until further guidance is issued from the CDC and Pinal County Health Dept and the CAA for Varsity sports.

### **Visitors/Volunteers**

At this time, in order to limit exposure to the COVID-19 virus, we will not be allowing any additional visitors or volunteers into the school buildings or classrooms until the risk has decreased according to the CDC and Pinal County Health.

### **Transportation Update**

As a safety precaution due to COVID-19, we are taking the following steps to reduce and prevent the spread of the virus to other students and staff on the bus.

- Due to the limited amount of space on the bus where physical distancing of six feet cannot be maintained we are **requiring** all students to wear a face mask that covers their nose and mouth **at all times** while they are on the school bus. Students can wear bandanas, fabric masks or neck gaiters.
- Students will also have assigned seating.

- Foggers will be used for cleaning using a NON toxic Virucide to eliminate viruses and bacteria from all surfaces in the school bus before and after usage.

- In the event a student has a fever, the student will be isolated until they can be picked up. **NO** transportation will be provided home for the students if they become ill.  
We request that all parents temperature check their students prior to boarding the school bus. No students will be admitted onto the bus or school with a temperature of 100.4 and above.
